





Income and Spending

Households in Brunswick County earn a median yearly income of \$62,951. 40.5% of the households earn more than the national average each year. Household expenditures average \$55,978 per year. The majority of earnings get spent on Shelter, Transportation, Food and Beverages, Health Care, and Utilities.


